# **SERVICE**

- 1. For charging, use a power adapter with a USB-A port and at least 1A output (adapter not included). You can also power the charging station directly from the game console.
- 2. Place the game controller from above into one of the ports on the charging station so that the 4 pins on the

- charging station make contact with the ports on the game controller.
- 3. When the controller is properly connected to the charging station, the red LED light will illuminate to indicate that charging is in progress.
- Completion of charging is indicated by the red LED going off and the blue LED coming on.

# **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**
